#### NOTICE OF A SPECIAL ELECTION

#### TO BE HELD BY THE CITY OF BROWNSVILLE, TEXAS

TIME AND PURPOSE OF ELECTION: To the registered voters of the County of Cameron, Texas, notice is hereby given that the City of Brownsville, Texas (the "City") will hold a Special Election in and throughout the City of Brownsville, including its extraterritorial jurisdiction, on *Saturday, May 4*, 2024, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., which is within the time prescribed by law, at the places designated herein, as may be amended by the Elections Administrator, on the two propositions contained herein that relate to the questions of the creation of the Greater Brownsville Municipal Development District contingent on whether a majority of the qualified voters approving the termination of the Type A corporation (Greater Brownsville Incentives Corporation) and Type B corporation (Brownsville Community Improvement Corporation).

Chapter 377 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that a municipality may call an election on the question of creating a municipal development district to plan, acquire, establish, develop, construct, or renovate one or more development projects beneficial to the district. Additionally, Chapters 504 and 505 of the Texas Local Government Code provide that a municipality may call an election on the question of terminating a Type A corporation (Greater Brownsville Incentives Corporation) and Type B corporation (Brownsville Community Improvement Corporation).

**BALLOT FORM**: The official ballot form shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code Section 52.073, which provides that the ballot shall be prepared so that a voter may vote "For" or "Against" a proposition. Also, it is estimated that there will be no anticipated fiscal impact to the City of Brownsville for any of the proposed propositions if approved.

<u>Proposition A</u>: Authorizing the creation of the Greater Brownsville Municipal Development District and the imposition of a sales and use tax at the rate of one-half of one percent (0.50%) for the purpose of financing development projects beneficial to the district, within the incorporated City limits and extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Brownsville, Texas, which boundaries shall automatically conform to any changes in the corporate boundaries and extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City, contingent upon the majority of eligible voters approving a ballot proposition to terminate the Brownsville Community Improvement Corporation and the Greater Brownsville Incentives Corporation.

ELECTORS: ONLY THE DULY QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY DETERMINED TO BE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE IN THE SPECIAL ELECTION SHALL BE PERMITTED TO VOTE IN THIS ELECTION FOR PROPOSITIONS A AND B. THE DULY QUALIFIED VOTERS WITHIN

THE CITY'S EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION WILL BE PERMITTED TO VOTE ON PROPOSITION A ONLY. State law prevents the extraterritorial jurisdiction from participating in the termination of the Brownsville Community Improvement Corporation and the Greater Brownsville Incentives Corporation since said area did not participate in the creation of the Type A and B corporations.

<u>PLACE OF ELECTION</u>: On Election Day, voters must vote in the precinct where registered to vote, unless the countywide polling place program is being used in the election:
